How to Write Haiku

There are different kinds of haiku. The most common is three lines long and contains exactly 17 syllables. The point of haiku is to capture one moment, one idea.

A single droplet falls silently to the ground the rumbling ceases.

In your haiku, remember: Identify the object, what it is doing and where. The lines do not have to be in this order.
